ENGLISH AND MATHS TIMETABLE CHANGES

TOP TIPS FOR PARENTS

- Help plan revision timetable and stick to it! 2 out of 3 sessions in a day. Morning, afternoon or evening if a weekend or holiday.
- Make sure they vary what they do. They need to make notes, spider diagrams, use the internet – not just read!
- Build in treats as you go – something daily to enjoy – like a TV programme and a weekly treat as a reward if they have worked hard all week.
- Encourage them to get help in school – after school classes, holiday sessions.
- Talk to them about coursework – due by and celebrate when it's done.
- Keep them well fed and watered. In the middle of a tough exam period their favourite meal may be something to look forward to.
- Encourage helpful notes displayed in their room – visual stimulus to recall in exam like spider diagrams or mind maps.
- Find a room they enjoy studying in that works for them if they don't have their own room. Give them some space!
