Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that, after careful consideration, we will be implementing some price increases in our restaurant with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> September this year.

This is not a decision we have taken lightly and we have managed to freeze prices for a number of years but the rising cost of ingredients and staffing have forced us to re-evaluate. Please rest assured that we have kept the increases to a minimum. The price of the main meal will rise from £2.00 to £2.20 and the meal deal (main course and a dessert/fruit) will rise from £2.40 to £2.60. Our website will be updated over the summer break to include new menus and updated prices so please have a look before your child returns to school in September:
